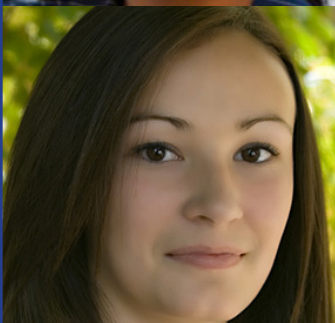


Services Include:
