

RESPECT 101: A classroom guide



Motivational Moment Activity

Have two students begin the class with a three to five-minute presentation—and come up with two or three discussion questions—based on their interests. Have the students think about what they do for fun, what topics they are interested in or passionate about, what their cultural identities are and how they practice those identities, what they hope to do in the future.

The presentation must be related to the course content in a real-world context. **Students may include a video for visuals and increased engagement, but it's optional.**

Have the rest of the class partner up to discuss their questions for one minute and then give them the opportunity to share out to the whole class.

This exercise gives **your students insight into their peers' interests.**
