The Safe Home's greatest need is supermarket/grocery/gas gift cards and financial contributions of all amounts so that we have the flexibility to act immediately to each of our client's unique situations as they arise.

Gift Cards

Gift cards are most helpful in responding to current shelter needs and give staff the opportunity to purchase perishable items such as milk, eggs, and bread. Consider a gift card to Meijer, Walmart, Oleson's Food Stores, D&W Fresh Market, Grain Train, major gas stations, or VISA gift cards.
